Barrington Hills Polo Club Announces Memorial Day Weekend Polo Tournament

THE BARRINGTON HILLS POLO CLUB will host Chicagoland's first polo tournament of 2018, *The Great Lakes Arena Cup and Great Lakes Memorial Cup* at its Wauconda, Ill., arena on Saturday and Sunday, May 26 and May 27. Co-hosting the event will be St. Croix Polo Club of Woodville, Wisc. Players from across the Midwest are expected to participate including those from Illinois, Wisconsin, Iowa, and Minnesota.

The Great Lakes Polo Event will consist of two flights of competitive polo each day. The Great Lakes Arena Cup will feature teams with gross handicaps of 0 to 3 goals. The Great Lakes Memorial will feature teams with gross handicaps of 3 to 6 goals. Polo players are issued handicaps ranging from Minus-2 to Plus-10. The sum of a team's player handicaps establishes the team's gross handicap. Handicaps are assigned by the United States Polo Association (USPA) which is sanctioning the tournament.

The tournament will take place in the club's USPA-regulation size outdoor arena located at Fox Creek Stable, 23815 Milton Road in Wauconda. The first match will begin at 11 a.m. on Saturday. Spectators are welcome. For more information and start times visit www.BarringtonHillsPolo.com.
